

ON-LINE

UNDER-SADDLE

1	CATCH	Horse is caught without evasion
2	HALTER	Horse turns towards, lowers, & holds head still for haltering
3	TOUCH	Horse can be touched all over with flag, rope, & plastic bag
4	SPACE	Horse stands while swinging a rope around & cracking a stockwhip
5	TARP	Horse follows, drags, crosses, stands on & carries a tarp
6	SOUND	Horse is exposed to a wide variety of 'scary' sounds
7	STAND	Horse stands while held online & when tied for up to 3 hours
8	FINGERS	Horse moves in all directions from fingertips
9	ENERGY	Horse moves in all directions from non-contact energy
10	LEAD	Horse leads from the shoulder walk, trot, halt, turns & backup
11	CIRCLE	Horse circles with balance at all gaits
12	TRANSITIONS	Horse transitions up & down through all gaits
13	SIDEWAYS	Horse travels sideways from the side & in front
14	NARROW	Horse walks forwards, backwards & underneath through narrow spaces
15	POLES	Horse negotiates ground poles forwards, backwards & sideways
16	JUMP	Horse clears small jumps & can stop, turn & wait after a jump
17	PATTERNS	Horse can figure 8, weave, & rollback
18	OBSTACLES	Horse sends through gates, crosses water & negotiates hills & ditches
19	PEDESTAL	Horse stands on a pedestal
20	WEATHER	Horse is exposed to umbrella, raincoat & fly repellent spray
21	DRIVE	Horse drives one & two reins at all gaits
22	ROPE	Horse performs all online exercises with a neck rope (no halter)
23	TRAFFIC	Horse leads calmly near traffic
24	BEAUTY	Horse stands quietly for grooming, hosing & clippers
25	HEALTH	Horse accepts injection, worm paste & farrier simulations
26	FLOAT	Horse walks into the float, stands & backs out, directed from outside

1	SADDLE	Horse stands still for saddling
2	BRIDLE	Horse turns towards, lowers head, & takes up the bit
3	WARM UP	Horse responsively warms up on-line at all gaits & jumps
4	MOUNTING	Horse positions & stands for mounting from ground or a block
5	CONTROL	Horse turns softly to direct reins, indirect reins & backing
6	TOUCH	Horse stands while rubbed all over with hands and legs
7	BASICS	Horse rides at all gaits, turns, stops, stands & backs up
8	FOLLOW	Horse follows a fenceline & a trail at all gaits
9	CIRCLE	Horse circles with balance at all gaits
10	TRANSITIONS	Horse transitions up & down through all gaits
11	STRAIGHT	Horse travels straight at all gaits
12	PIVOTS	Horse turns on FQ & HQ 360°
13	SOFT FEEL	Horse accepts a soft feel at all gaits
14	SIDEWAYS	Horse travels sideways shoulder-in & haunches-in
15	PATTERNS	Horse rides figure 8s, weaves, & rollbacks
16	NARROW	Horse rides forwards & backwards through a narrow space
17	JUMP	Horse clears small jumps & can stop, turn & wait after a jump
18	DROVE	Horse drives livestock
19	BARRELS	Horse performs a 6 barrel pattern at all gaits
20	DRAG	Horse drags items with a rope
21	CARRY	Horse rides with a 45' rope flag, plastic bag & tarp
22	TRAIL	Horse negotiates hills, ditches, water, gates, wildlife, & traffic
23	TRAFFIC	Horse rides calmly near traffic
24	WEATHER	Horse rides in the rain, the wind & the dark
25	COMPANY	Horse rides alone, in a group & leading another horse
26	TRAVEL	Horse floats out for riding

NOTE: As horses are living, thinking, decision making animals such as ourselves, competence in all the above tasks will vary depending on the individual level of a horse's innate instincts (born with), previous experiences and their results (learned along the way), along with the current level of the owners knowledge and skills.
